SUBJECT: Change of Policy - Summer Benefits for Language Courses

1. References.

- a. Cadet Command Regulation 145-1, chapters 2-7, 7 May 2008.
- b. Cadet Command Pamphlet 145-1, chapter 2-7, 14 March 2008.

2. Cadet Command is changing the summer school policy to allow students (excluding graduate students) to take courses in the approved Critical Language Incentive Pay (CLIP) program during the summer term without penalizing their approved Normal Academic Progression System (NAPS) number of terms. This will ensure students have the opportunity take these critical courses without migrating to another mission set and also without losing a term of their scholarship benefits.

- a. Upon approval of their CLIP payment by G3, the student's NAPS will automatically be increased one term for each summer term in which a Cadet participates in an approved CLIP course (not to exceed the statutory requirement to remain within 10 semesters or 15 quarters).

- b. A summer benefit approval will also be loaded into CCIMS Personnel Action System to ensure payment by the G4/8.

3. Enclosure one is the DA Form 2028 outlining the changes that will be made to reference a. Enclosure two is the DA Form 2028 outlining the changes that will be made to reference b.

4. Effective 1 January 2009, Cadets can plan summer courses for the languages listed in the new Appendix N to CC Pam 145-1 listed on enclosure two. Graduate students are excluded from this program as we are limited by law to paying 20 months of benefits for those cadets.
